INFORMATION CLAUSE

Under Article 13 of the Resolution 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) of 27th April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free flow of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as: GDPR) we inform you as follows:

- 1. The administrator of your personal data is Katolicka Agencja Informacyjna sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Warsaw, Skwer Kard. S. Wyszyńskiego 9, 01-015 Warsaw ("Administrator").
- 2. Your personal data will be processed in order to:
 - a) provide accreditation for the press service of the beatification ceremony of Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński and Mother Elżbieta Róża Czacka on September 12, 2021 in the Church of Divine Providence in Warsaw ("Event"), based on your consent (legal basis: Art. 6, paragraph 1 (a) of the GDPR);
 - b) for purposes resulting from the legitimate interests of the Administrator, consisting in the organization and ensuring the proper course of the Event (legal basis: Art. 6, paragraph 1, letter f of the GDPR).
- 3. Your personal data will be stored by the Administrator from the date of their acquisition until the expiry of a period of 45 days from the date of the Event.
- 4. Your personal data may be transferred to: entities processing them at the request of the Administrator, including those providing services in the field of maintaining the IT system and hosting the Administrator's e-mail, as well as public authorities or entities authorized to obtain data on the basis of applicable law. In particular, your data may be made available to the competent services responsible for the safe course of the Event.
- 5. Your personal data will not be processed for the purpose of automated decision making or profiling.
- 6. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries.
- 7. In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights: the right to access personal data; the right to request rectification (correction) of personal data; the right to request the deletion of personal data; the right to object to data processing.
- 8. You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data at any time. The withdrawal of the consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on the consent before its withdrawal.
- 9. If you become aware of the unlawful processing of your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority competent for the protection of personal data.
- 10. Providing personal data is voluntary, however, refusal to provide data will prevent the granting of accreditation and participation in the Event.
